1. CALL TO ORDER

Approval of Minutes from December 4, 2018

4a. Follow-up on Changes to Pre-Alert Procedures

After reviewing the reports, Operations Manager Kauffman reported the re-alert procedures does not interrupt the station and the alert will go out to the field on the portables. Testing will take place in Manhattan Beach with follow-up at the next meeting.

5. NEW BUSINESS

5a. Overview of INSB Operational Procedures

Operations Manager Kauffman reviewed the operational procedures. Before finalizing, there will be a group review before training. Battalion Chief Bonfield recommended training together. It was discussed to have a special meeting in the upcoming weeks for operational procedures with Manhattan Beach and El Segundo.

5b. ES Chat

The app is currently under-utilized with no activity. As the transition to digital trunk takes place, the ES Chat will stop with INSB. The next step will be Mark43 which will have increased mobility and more mobiles.

6. TASK FORCE MEMBER COMMENTS

Battalion Chief Bonfield commended dispatch for stepping up. Captain Allee mentioned when managing reserves, there was lag time. Now, with the switch done, it is good.

Radio and mobile installations are taking place, finishing up the last rig this week. Battalion Chief Hafdell inquired after the installs and cable splicing. Administrative Service Manager Krok reported the original order did not include the proper length and Technical Services attempted to make it work. Commline and Technical Services are working together to remedy this week.

With INSB going live in April, the system will be exercised and work with the group including Culver City. Training to keep radio discipline on dispatch channels at minimum or move to one of your own channels will help. Consoles will monitor access and everything is recorded.
